I have the honor to inform Your Excellency that, taking into consideration the excellent friendly relationship that binds the United Mexican States and the Federated States of Micronesia, the Government of the United Mexican States has decided to suppress the requirement of visa to the nationals of the Federated States of Micronesia holding a valid ordinary passport, who wish to travel into the territory of the United Mexican States, as visitors without permission for paid activities, for a period not exceeding 180 days, from the date of reception of this Note.

The Government of the United Mexican States hopes this will further foster the increase in tourism and economic exchange between Mexico and Micronesia, thereby strengthening the bonds of friendship and cooperation.

I avail myself of this opportunity to renew to Your Excellency the assurances of my highest and distinguished consideration.
